

Policies and Procedures



Please be sure to review all pre and post care instructions, along with pricing information before scheduling.

Important!

It is against WI state law for anyone under the age of 18 to receive a tattoo.
Parental consent does *not* override this state law; therefore, no one under the age of 18 will receive microblading.

Children under the age of 18 are also not allowed in the procedure room to observe.

Before the procedure:

Jill will draw your eyebrows on before doing any microblading. The client agrees to the size, shape, arch, and pigment color prior to starting any procedure.

If Jill feels as though you are not ready or comfortable enough to perform the procedure, she reserves the right to cancel your appointment. This is in your best interest, as she wants all clients to feel good about this decision.

Pricing changes:

Pricing is subject to change if you have had work done by another technician prior. This is sometimes considered "corrective" work based on the current condition of the existing eyebrow tattoo. Jill reserves the right to refuse working over an existing tattoo if she feels it needs to be removed in order for microblading to be effective.

In some situations, more than one touch-up may be necessary. If that is the case, you will be charged for the additional service depending upon the amount of work needing to be done.

No call/no show and cancellations:

Out of respect for other clients, if you are more than 15 minutes late for your appointment you will be asked to reschedule and you will forfeit your deposit.

Any client who is a no call/no show for a scheduled appointment will forfeit their deposit and will be required to pay for any future appointments in full.
